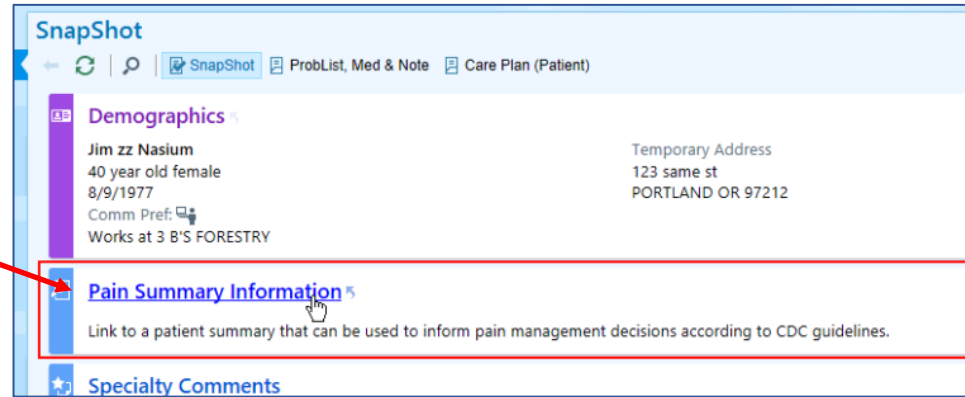


CDS Pain Management Summary Quick Start Guide

The Pain Management Summary displays relevant patient-centered data to inform pain management decisions. It includes concepts outlined in the CDC Guideline for Prescribing Opioids for Chronic Pain.

To View the Pain Management Summary:

- Log in to the EHR and select a patient
- View the patient “SnapShot”
- Click on the link to the “Pain Summary Information”
- The Pain Management Summary displays




Pain Management Summary

Take Notice: Reminder that the Summary is not intended for specific patients

Menu: Click on a menu option to go to that content on the summary

***Flags:** Highlights areas of potential concern

CDS Pain Management Summary Quick Start Guide

The Summary is intended for patients ≥ 18 yrs with a condition associated with chronic pain, or an opioid medication in the past 6 months, or an adjuvant analgesic in the past 6 months. The summary will NOT display for patients not meeting these criteria.

Pain Management Summary CDS Content

Pertinent Medical History (*unrestricted lookback*)

- Conditions Associated with Chronic Pain – and their date of onset
- Risk Factors for Opioid-related Harms – and their date of onset

Pain Assessments (*2-year lookback*)

- Wong-Baker FACES Rating Scale – scores and dates
- Pain Enjoyment General Activity (PEG) Assessments – scores and dates
- STarT Back Assessments – scores and dates

Historical treatments (*2-year lookback*)

- Opioid Medications – orders and statements with dates
- Non-Opioid Medications – orders and statements with dates
- Non-Pharmacologic Treatments – orders and referrals with dates
- Stool Softeners and Laxatives - orders and statements with dates (*6-month lookback*)

Risk Factors and Assessments

- †Most Recent MME – amount and date (*most recent*)
- Urine Drug Screens – date and result (*1-year lookback*)
- Benzodiazepine Medications – orders and statements with dates (*2-year lookback*)
- Naloxone Medications - orders and statements with dates (*unrestricted lookback*)
- Risk Screenings Relevant to Pain Management – score and date (*1-year lookback*)

*Pain Management Summary Flags

Pertinent Medical History

- Risk factors for Opioid-related Harms: Always flag if any are present (Depression, Anxiety, Substance Use Disorder, Suicide attempt, Sleep-disordered breathing, Renal dysfunction, Hepatic dysfunction, Pregnancy, 65 yrs or older)

Pain Assessments

- No flags

Historical treatments

- Opioid Medications: Flag if present
- Non-opioid Medications: Flag if NONE
- Non-pharmacologic Treatments: Flag if NONE
- Stool Softeners and Laxatives: Flag if not present AND at least one opioid medication is present

Risk Factors and Assessments

- †Most Recent MME: Flag if MME is greater than or equal to 50
- Urine Drug Screens: Flag if not present AND at least one opioid medication is present
- Benzodiazepine Medications: Flag if present AND at least one opioid medication; Flag if present (each flag has a different message)
- Naloxone Medications: Flag if not present AND most recent MME is 50+MME/day; Flag if present (each flag has a different message)

†MME amount is currently being implemented in the EHR
